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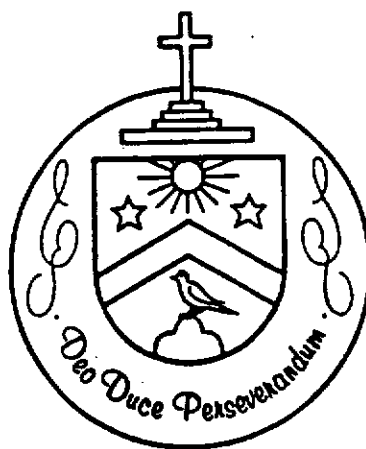

INTRODUCTION

The present, illustrated Jay family genealogy is based on early family documents, baptismal certificates, Bible entries, and cemetery records and tomb markers at the family burial sites in Rye and Bedford.

Auguste Jay (1665-1751), the first Jay to settle in America in 1685, started recording family data on the inside of the back cover of his Calvinist Bible. He began with the statement that he was born in La Rochelle in the Kingdom of France, and in New York married Anne Marie Bayard in 1697. The marriages, births, and deaths in the family are recorded as they occurred, first in French and later in English. These pages are reproduced for the first time in this publication. They are followed by a copy of an article which annotates these entries written by Edward F. DeLancey in the New York Genealogical and Biographical Record, Vol.VII, No.3, July 1876, pp.110-116.

Preserved in the family archives at Jay House, in addition to Auguste Jay's Bible, are the Clarkson Family Bible, with entries as late as 1950. Also at Jay House are the ancestral records of Banyer Clarkson (1854-1919) and of John Jay Pierrepont and Laura Jay Wells (1874-1938), younger sister of Mary Rutherford Jay (1872-1953), the renowned landscape architect, who diligently assembled the first Jay and related-families chart, three feet high and thirteen feet long, in 1935 and updated in 1948. In the foreword to her chart, she expressed the hope that someone in the future would continue this work. I consider it a great privilege to have been entrusted with this project by the Friends of John Jay Homestead. I, too, encourage the coming generations to keep these records updated. To make this task easier and more practicable, the pages are prepared ready for insertion in a 3-ring binder especially planned for this purpose. Because of the voluminous number of records still to be consulted, additional family data will be made available in the future as they are completed.

Bringing this genealogy up to date could not have been accomplished without the collaboration and help of the members of the various branches of this widespread family. I thank every one of them for their generous patience in checking up on their past and present, and for informing me about the welcome new arrivals.

My great appreciation goes to the Friends of the John Jay Homestead for their sincere interest in this project and for their continuous encouragement and support. I wish to express my warm thanks to my colleague Jane Begos for her invaluable assistance in supervising the printing and final assembly, and, lastly, to my wife, Leah, whose expertise in English and literary form was my guiding star throughout this undertaking.

FOREWORD

All of those devoted to the John Jay Homestead and the treasured memories this handsome residence evokes will ever remain in debt to our friend Lino S. Lipinsky de Orlov for what constitutes a labor of love and a masterpiece of genealogical research. At long last we have spread out on the record an eminent American family, the forbears, immediate family, and the many descendants of John Jay, the nation's first Chief Justice and a man who served the nation and state in many other capacities as well.

It was the special talent of the Jay family, beginning with its American founder, Auguste Jay, to advance their social and public position by appropriate marriages. Auguste, to start, married Anne Marie Bayard, with ties to the family of Governor Peter Stuyvesant, the Van Cortlandts, Van Rensselaers, and Schuylers. Peter in turn solidified the French Huguenot-Dutch blood ties by his marriage to Mary Van Cortlandt, while his son John added a Scottish heritage to the lineage by his marriage to Sarah Van Brugh Livingston, a daughter of William Livingston, intellectual and Patriot governor-to-be of New Jersey.

The prolific descendants of John and Sarah Livingston Jay have left their mark on America's cultural and political life, served on the bench, at the bar, in diplomacy, and the military branches, as well as in business, and often with high distinction. They fought against slavery, upheld the cause of Union, made contributions to science and sponsored philanthropic, humanitarian, and scholarly associations. The continuity of that notable record of achievement in so many varied fields gives special distinction to the Jay Family Genealogy.

AN EXPLANATION OF THE CODE AND ABBREVIATIONS USED

The initials indicate from whom the person is descended. The number following the initials indicates the generation down from Auguste Jay, who established the Jay family in America. The number after the slant mark (/) indicates the person's numerical sequence in that generation. Thus the code "wm 7/6" before the name of John Jay Chapman, indicates that he is a descendant of the William Jay branch of the family, the sixth in order on the chart in the seventh generation after Auguste Jay.

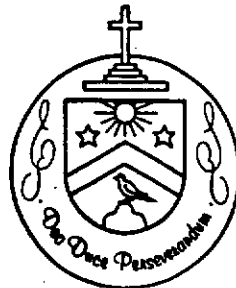

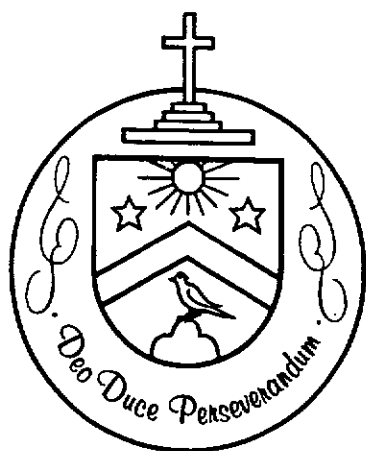

La Rochelle was one of the chief centers of Calvinism. The revocation of the Edict of Nantes (1685) deprived it of thousands of its most industrious inhabitants, notable among them the Jay family, successful and prosperous merchants.

Pierre Jay escaped with his family to England, while his son Auguste (1665-1751) came to New York in 1685, starting the American branch of the Jay family. His grandson John Jay (1745-1829) became one of the most outstanding statesmen of the United States.

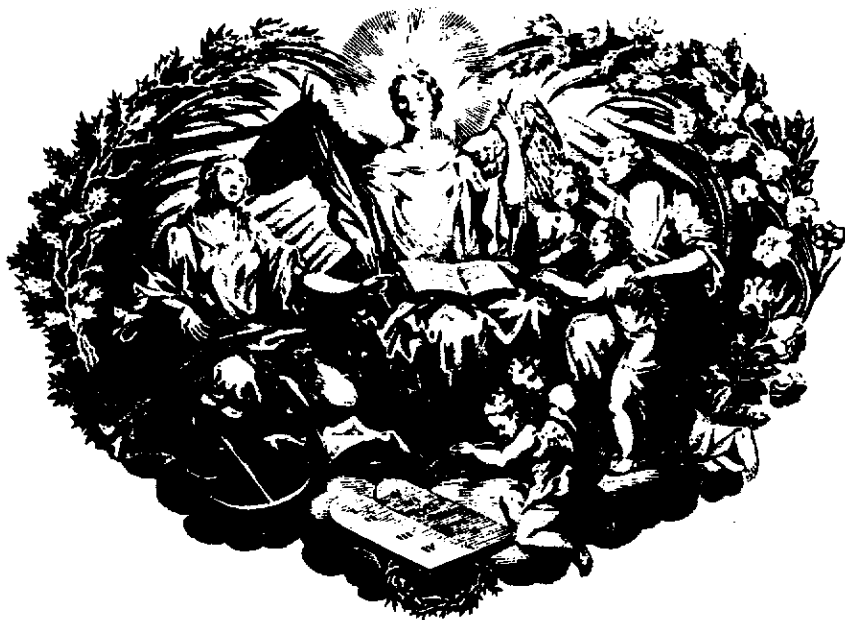

ORIGINAL FAMILY RECORDS—JAY.

Contributed by EDWARD F. DE LANCY.

IN the possession of Dr. John C. Jay, of Rye, Westchester County, New York, is the family Bible of *Augustus Jay*, the first of this family in America. The following record, written in old French, is begun on the inside of the last cover of the book, continued on the fly-leaf immediately preceding, and is that of Augustus Jay himself. It states his own birth at Rochelle, in 1665, his marriage, in New York, in 1697, to Anna Maria, or Anne Marie, Bayard, second daughter and third child of Balthazar Bayard and Maria Loockermans his wife, and the births, marriages, and deaths, in his family, as they occur, down to 1739, when the record ends.

Balthazar Bayard was the eldest son of Nicholas Bayard by his wife Anna Stuyvesant, sister of the Director Peter Stuyvesant, with whom, being then a widow with three sons (Balthazar, Peter, and Nicholas), she came from Holland to New Amsterdam, where they all landed on May 14, 1647. The volume itself is a large and heavy folio, in French, published at Amsterdam in 1707, containing notes to the text and some curious copperplate illustrations and maps. It has two title-pages, the first a large and elaborate copperplate engraving representing Moses delivering the law, with various other Jewish and Christian emblems and allegorical devices. In the centre of the engraving is an open book, bearing on its leaves these words in five lines of small capitals: "La Sainte Bible, Expliquee par Mr. Martin." In front of, and below, the open leaves, upon a stand, appears a censer of burning incense, the smoke of which partially covers the page so inscribed. Beneath the plate are the words "À Amsterdam chez H. Desbordes, P. Mortier & P. Brunel, Libraires," in small capitals.

The printed second title gives the date M.DCCVII., and Amsterdam as the place, of publication, and states that the notes to the text and the prefaces to the Old and New Testaments are by David Martin, Pastor of the Walloon Church of "Utrechth."

The book has no clasps, is bound in old calf with gilt back and edges, and has the top, front, and bottom finished in black and red mottling, now faded with age, but perfectly distinct when the volume is closed.

Following the record of *Augustus Jay*, is here given that of his only son, *Peter Jay*. This is not from any Bible, but from an old manuscript on a sheet of quarto paper in the possession of the writer, to whom it has descended from his maternal great-grandmother, Eve Jay, the eldest child of *Peter Jay*, who married the Rev. Dr. Harry Munro, the last rector of St. Peter's Church, Albany, prior to the Revolution. It gives his marriage to Mary, daughter of Jacobus van Cortlandt of Yonkers, and the births of his ten children, the seventh child and sixth son, John,

being the celebrated Governor of New York and Chief-Justice of the United States, the deaths of two sons and one daughter, the marriage of his eldest daughter, Eve, and the birth of her only child Peter Jay Munro, extending from 1728 to 1767.

Both records are given verbatim. The first is in old French, except five entries, which are in English. The abbreviation "M^r." is for Monsieur, "parrain" and "marraine" mean godfather and godmother, and "eglise" church; "p," which often occurs, is an abbreviation of "pour," for. Sometimes the same word is spelled differently in different entries, and the old spelling of the French names of the months and days of the week is used throughout. The punctuation of the original is also retained. With these explanations, it is believed that the record will be understood by any one, though not conversant with French. The first five entries of Augustus's record have no marginal dates, but they have here been added, that the eye may easily follow the sequence of dates from the beginning.

The entry of the baptism of Peter Jay Munro is on a separate paper, in the handwriting of his father the Rev. Dr. Harry Munro, fastened to the manuscript. A few of the first entries in Peter's record appear also in that of his father. The last two entries are in Peter Jay Munro's handwriting.

None of the sons of *Peter Jay*, except Chief-Justice John Jay, the sixth, left issue, nor did either of his daughters, except his eldest child Eve, wife of Dr. Harry Munro. The descendants of these two children are therefore the only representatives of Peter Jay.

Chief-Justice Jay married, in April 1774, Sarah, youngest daughter of Gov. William Livingston, of New Jersey, and had two sons—Peter Augustus, born 24th Jan., 1776, and William, born 16th June, 1789, who both left issue;* and four daughters, Susan, Maria, Ann, and Sarah Louisa, of whom Maria, the wife of Goldsborough Banyar (the son of that Goldsborough Banyar who was so long the Provincial Deputy Secretary of New York) was the only one who married, but she left no issue. All the Chief-Justice's children are dead.

The only child of Eve Jay and Dr. Harry Munro, Peter Jay Munro, married Margaret, second daughter of the Hon. Henry White of the Governor's Council of the Province of New York and his wife Eve,† second daughter of Frederick Van Cortland of Yonkers, and Frances Jay, his wife, third daughter of Augustus Jay, and had four sons, Peter Jay, Peter Jay second, Henry, and John White, of whom only Henry had issue, and eight daughters, Margaret, Mary, Frances (wife of the Right Rev. William H. De Lancey, Bishop of Western New York), Harriet (wife of Augustus Frederick Van Cortlandt, of Yonkers), Mary second, Anne-Maria (wife of Elias Desbrosses Hunter), Sarah Jay (wife of Asa Whitney), and Cordelia. Except Sarah Jay Whitney, all his married daughters left issue. His children are now all dead except John W. Munro and Mary Munro second. His own death took place on 22d September, 1833.

Augustus Jay escaped from Rochelle at the Revocation of the Edict of

Nantes, in 1685, and landed at Charleston, South Carolina. He died in New York on the 10th March, 1751, at the age of eighty-six.†

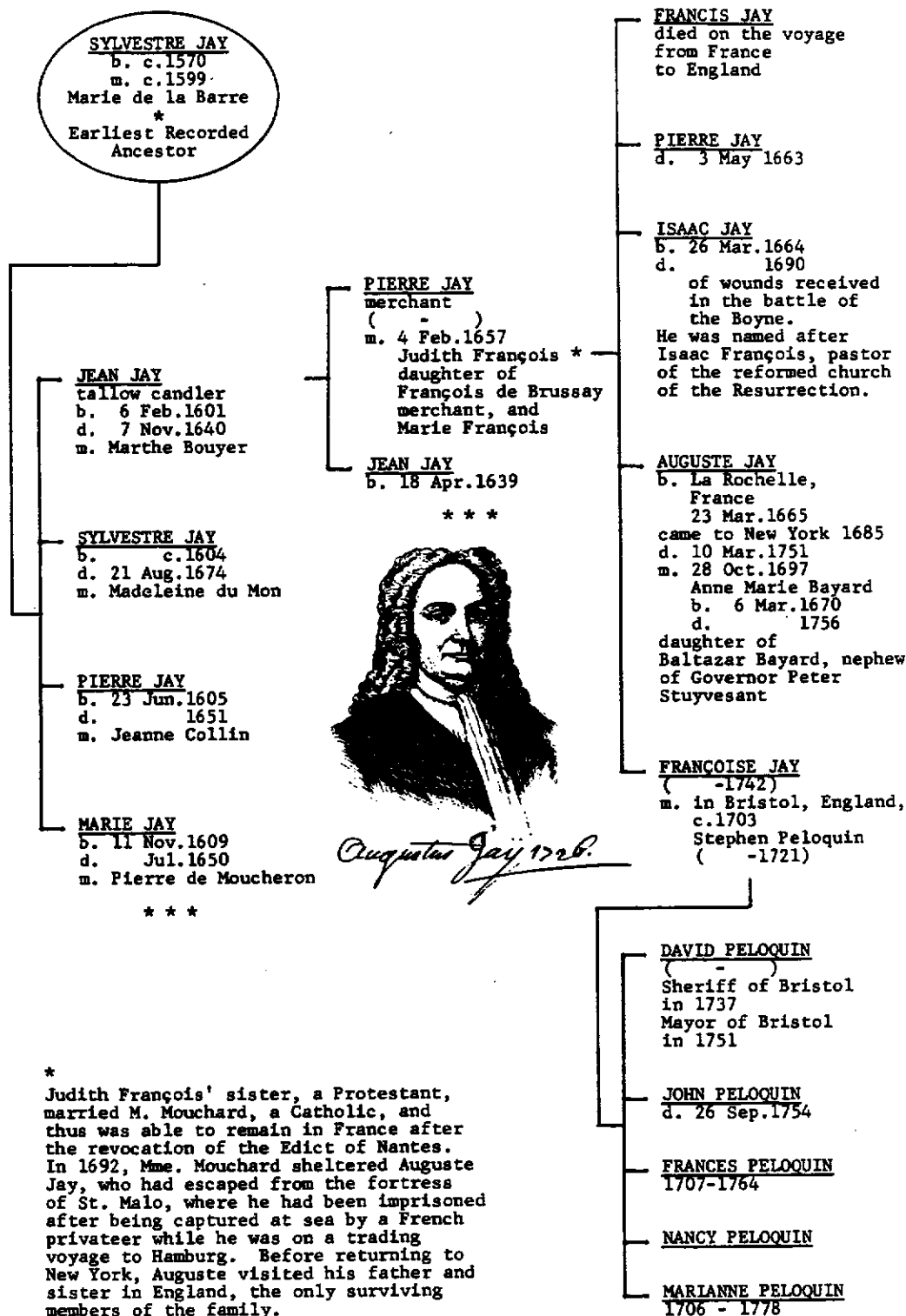

married M. Mouchard, a Catholic, and
thus was able to remain in France after
the revocation of the Edict of Nantes.
In 1692, Mme. Mouchard sheltered Auguste
Jay, who had escaped from the fortress
of St. Malo, where he had been imprisoned
after being captured at sea by a French
privateer while he was on a trading
voyage to Hamburg. Before returning to
New York, Auguste visited his father and
sister in England, the only surviving
members of the family.

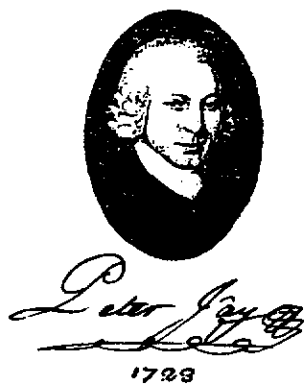

MUNRO, Henry, clergyman, b. in Inverness, Scotland, in 1730; d. in Edinburgh, 30 May, 1801. He was graduated at the University of St. Andrews, studied divinity at Edinburgh university, and in 1757 was ordained, and appointed chaplain to the 77th Highlanders, which he accompanied in Gen. John Forbes's expedition to Fort Duquesne. He was also at the capture of Crown Point, Ticonderoga, and Montreal in 1760, and preached a thanksgiving sermon to the victorious army on the hill behind the last-named city. He afterward served in the West Indies, but returned to this country in 1762 and settled in Princeton, N. J. He then took orders in the Church of England, and in the year 1763 became missionary at Yonkers, where Col. Frederick Philipse had built a church. In 1768 he became rector of St. Peter's, Albany, and also acted, at Sir William Johnson's request, as missionary to the Mohawk Indians, whose language he spoke and whom he frequently visited. As an officer in the old French war, he acquired 2,000 acres of bounty land in Washington county, N. Y., and attempted to settle it, but the Revolution interfered, and it was subsequently sold by his son. Mr. Munro's church was closed by the Albany committee of safety in 1777, and he was imprisoned, but escaped to the British lines, and returned to Great Britain in 1778. In 1782 the University of St. Andrews gave him the degree of D. D. He married in 1762 Miss Stockton, of New Jersey, and, after her death, married, in 1766, Eve, only daughter of Peter Jay, who, with their son, remained in this country after Mr. Munro's flight to England.

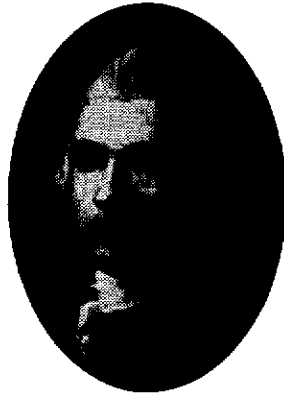

James Jay was the fourth child of Peter Jay (1704-1780) and Mary Van Cortlandt (1705-1777). He was 13 years older than his brother John Jay (1745-1829), the first Chief Justice of the United States.

James graduated as a medical doctor from the University of Edinburgh, and while abroad, raised funds for a medical school at King's College, the present Columbia University. In 1763, James Jay was knighted by King George III for his service to the cause of education in the British Colonies.

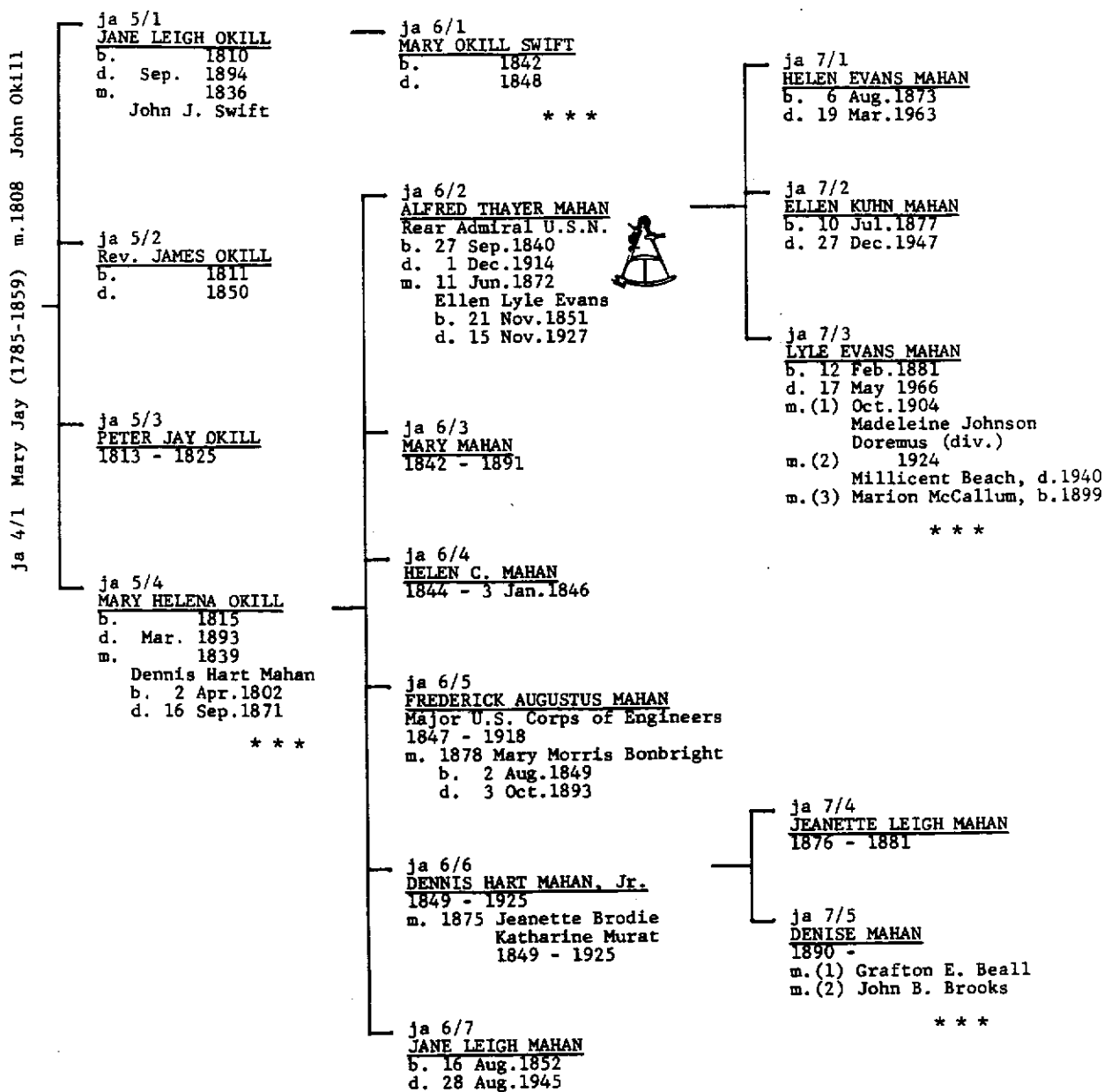

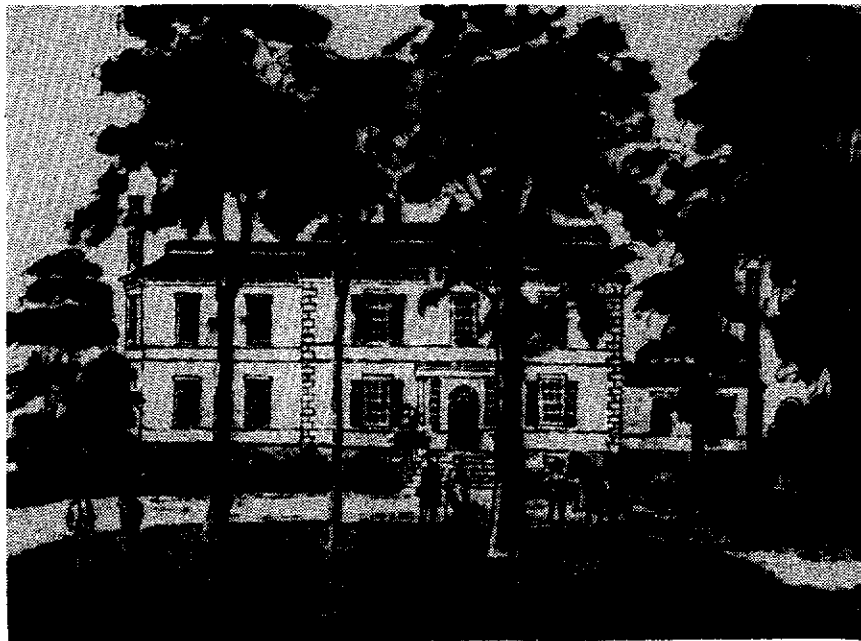

Anna Maria Jay (1819-1902) was the fifth child (pa 5/5) of Peter Augustus Jay (1776-1843) and his wife Mary Rutherford Clarkson (1786-1838), daughter of General Matthew Clarkson and his wife Mary Rutherford. In 1841 Anna Maria married Henry Evelyn Pierrepont (1808-1888), son of Hezekiah Beers Pierrepont and his wife Anna Maria Constable. Henry Pierrepont was a banker and landowner in Brooklyn, and served as Trustee and Treasurer of the General Theological Seminary. They had six children, three sons and three daughters.

EDWARD PELLEW, b. 19 April, 1757, having entered early the naval service of his country, soon became a distinguished member of that gallant profession, and won his way to fame and fortune. Mr. Pellew was, in 1780, appointed a lieutenant, and in the May of the same year received his commission of post-captain. On 29 June, 1793, he received the honour of knighthood; and on 5 March, 1796, he was created a Baronet for his heroic conduct in capturing the "Cleopatra" French frigate; and having risen to the rank of admiral of the Blue, was elevated to the peerage, 1 June, 1814, as *Baron Exmouth, of Cannonteign, co. Devon*. His lordship was advanced to a viscountcy by the title of VISCOUNT EXMOUTH, 21 Sept. 1816, for his gallantry in bombarding and destroying the fleet and arsenal of Algiers during that year. 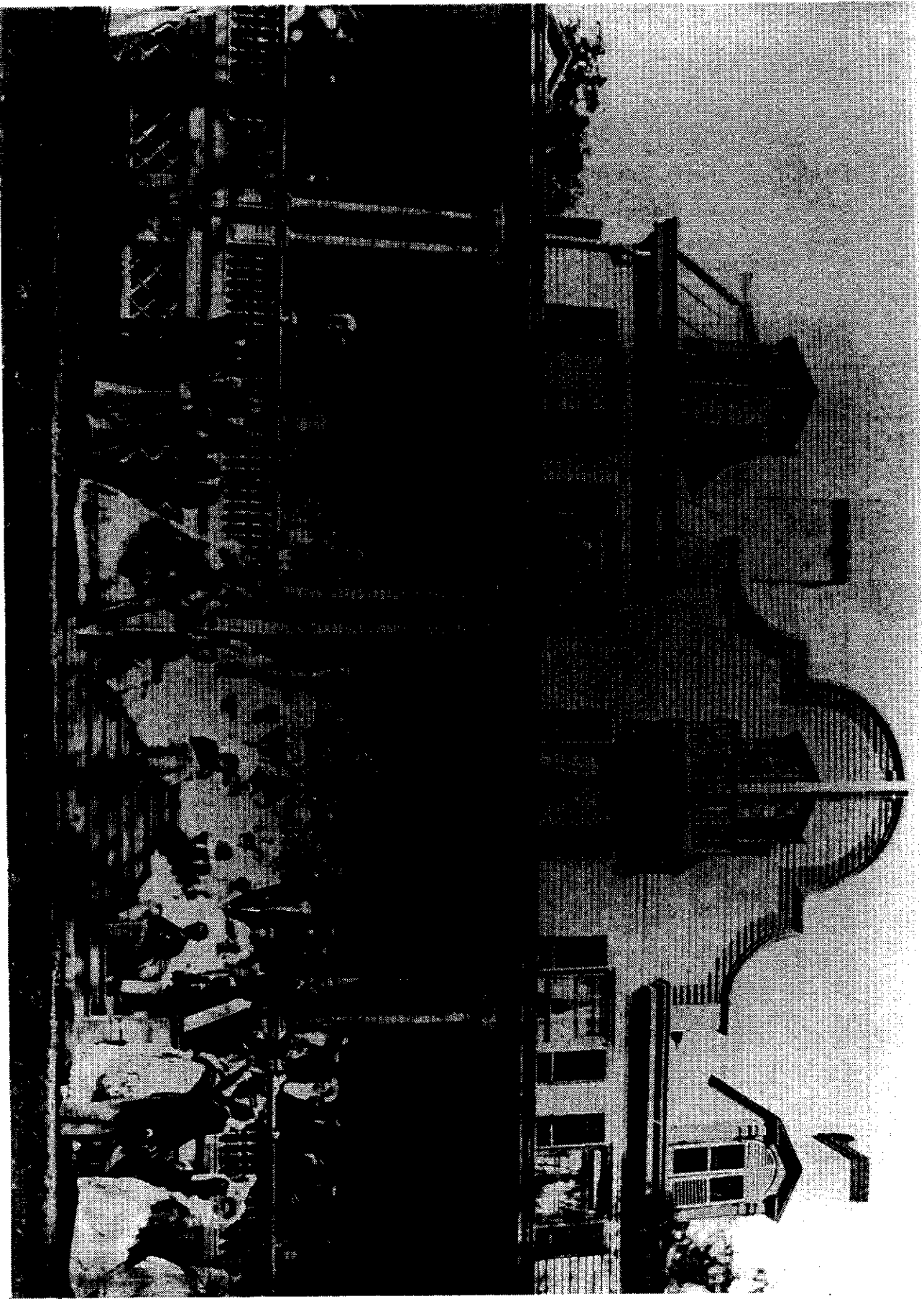

Mary Jay (1846-1916) was the fifth child (wm 6/12) of John Jay II (1817-1894) and his wife, Eleanor Kingsland Field (1819-1909). In 1863 she married at Bedford, New York, William Henry Schieffelin of New York City. He was the son of Samuel Bradhurst Schieffelin and his wife, Lucretia Hazard, daughter of Captain William and Lucretia (Holmes) Hazard of Norwich, Conn. As early as the thirteenth century, the Schieffelins were a notable family of Nördlingen, Germany. The family in America traces back from Jacob Schieffelin (Philadelphia, 1740) and his son, Jacob, who married Regina Margaretha Richthofen. Their son, Jacob 3rd, was the founder of the Schieffelin mercantile house in New York City. William Henry Schieffelin was the great-grandson of Jacob 3rd.

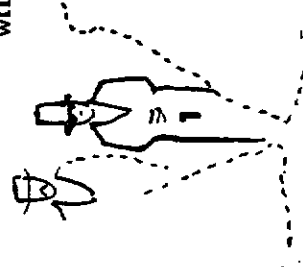
The seventeen-year old bride, seated next to the groom in the center, was the fifth child (4th daughter) of John Jay II and Eleanor Kingsland Field (shielding her face from the sun with a fan), both standing behind the bride,

The bride's brother William Jay, who was to be a groomsman at the wedding, was not granted a leave from his duties as senior aide-de-camp at the headquarters of the 5th Corps of the Army of the Potomac in Virginia under General Sykes.

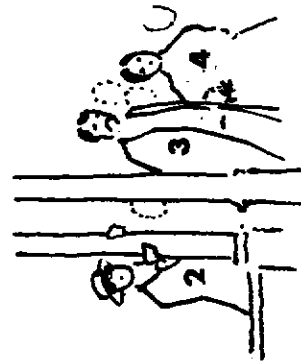
Eleanor Jay, the bride's eldest sister, and her husband Henry Grafton Chapman are standing on the left, next to the columns. On their left is the Reverend Edward Boggs (with flat hat), the fourth rector of St. Matthew's Church from 1855 until 1866.

On the left, standing on the ground, the old man in a top hat had been personal valet to Chief Justice Jay. Standing on the ground, next to the banister on the right, is Levi Parsons Morton, U.S. Vice President in 1889 and Governor of New York in 1895.

The neo-baroque central gable had been added to the house a few years before, probably after the death of William Jay in 1858, by John Jay II, who also altered the front porch and widened it.

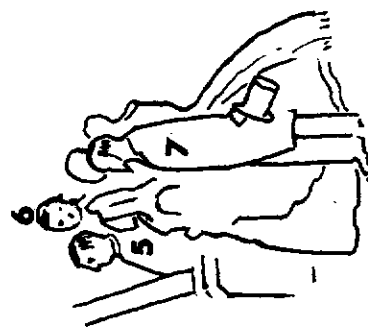


1 John Jay's old valet
