

TRANSCRIPTS OF CRIMINAL CASES IN NEW YORK CITY

Shorthand minutes are taken during the course of trial proceedings by a court stenographer. In the past this was done by hand in stenographic notebooks, but at the present time minutes are usually created through the use of stenotype machines. Transcripts of the minutes are made for the use of the court or the attorneys involved in the case only under certain circumstances. At trials of class A and class B felonies, the judge may order the stenographer to transcribe proceedings daily as the trial is progressing. Stenographers alternate in the court room and spend the time out of court typing the transcripts. This is called "daily copy." Court reporters are not required to transcribe their minutes if not requested to do so by the judge or by the defense attorney.

When a criminal case is decided in a defendant's favor, no appeal will be made. No need exists in such cases for a transcript of the trial proceedings. In cases in which daily copy was produced, the reporter may destroy the copy if he wishes, or he may retain it in his files.

When the defendant is found guilty, his case may be appealed. In that case, the judge will usually order a transcript of the trial to be made for use in the appeals hearing. The defense attorney may purchase a copy of the transcript, and the prosecuting attorney will also receive one. In cases where the defense cannot afford to purchase a transcript, the court must make provision for a copy for the defense. Court reporters are always paid for producing transcripts.

The courts are required by law to keep the minutes, i.e. the stenotype tapes. In fact, since 1971, a program to microfilm all court reporters' minutes has been underway in New York City. Reporters are supposed to send their tapes to the microfilming unit. The potential for loss is great since adequate storage facilities do not exist for the court reporters and the microfilming project is

several years behind. Access to the minutes is by court reporter's name. A complete record of which reporters cover what trials is kept by the court reporters' office in the Criminal Court. If the record of a particular trial is needed, the reporter of record is determined, and a request for the minutes he took on the dates of the trial is sent to the microfilm unit. The microfilm is then made available to the stenographer to transcribe in the event of a reopening of a trial, or a future appeal. Should the original reporter no longer be available to do the transcript, another will be hired for the job. Again, the reporter will be paid for producing the transcript.

Cases from the New York City Criminal Court (lesser offenses) and cases from the Supreme Court, Criminal Branch (felonies) are usually first appealed to the Appellate Division of the Supreme Court. When a case goes to the appeals court, all of the paperwork connected with the case is compiled by the Appeals Bureau. Transcripts of size, usually over 100 pages, are treated as separate documents and are given numbers by the Appeals Bureau. This number, colloquially known as the "stenographic or steno number," is stamped or written on the cover of the transcript. At present, as a money-saving effort, the daily copy, if available, is used by the court as the copy of record. The transcript remains with the court documents throughout the appeals process; at the conclusion, the transcript is sent directly to the Criminal Court Library, where it is kept, arranged by steno number. Transcripts of fewer than 100 pages are not treated as separate documents. They are filed with other trial records by the Appeals Bureau. Most transcripts are more than 100 pages long.

It is not clear when the system of numbering trial transcripts in the Appeals Bureau began; nor is it certain when they began to be stored in the Criminal Court Library. The Appellate Division of the Supreme Court was created by a court reform act in 1894 and began its work in 1896. However, cases from

the Court of General Sessions were appealed to similar appeals bodies prior to that time. There is an almost complete series of transcripts in existence with steno numbers starting at 1 and continuing to the present day (approximately *10900). In fact, record books listing these transcripts are kept in the Appeals Bureau. The first book contains an alphabetical listing of defendants with accompanying steno numbers through the year 1929 (approximately steno number 4800). From an examination of the transcripts, it is clear that the numbers do not form a strict chronological sequence: *1 is a trial in 1908, while numbers in the 2000's are trials that took place in the 1880's and 1890's. However, there is a single complete numerical sequence, and after the beginning of the 2000's, the numbers do become more or less chronological. It is a reasonable speculation that the system of assigning steno numbers began in 1908 (perhaps that is when the record book was started) and that numbers were retrospectively assigned to court reporters' works as they were entered into the record book. Once the backlog had been numbered, the numbering system seems to reflect a chronological listing of cases sent to the Appellate Division.

In 1972, the transcripts with steno numbers from 1-3666 were offered to the John Jay College Library. The reasons for this are not clear, although it is probable that crowded conditions in the Appeals Bureau or the Criminal Court Library necessitated the removal of some records. A request was made of John Jay to produce a catalog of what had been received, but lack of staff and money made this impossible at the time. Exactly what this collection contained was not understood when it was sent to John Jay. Over the years, personnel changes both in the Criminal Court and at John Jay lead to confusion over what was in the John Jay collection. However, it was obvious that it had historical significance and that the collection was in a deteriorating condition. As a result, John Jay applied for and received a grant from the National Endowment

for the Humanities to microfilm the collection. This was carried out in 1983-4. An index to this set of transcripts is now in preparation which will include access to these transcripts by type of offense, defendant's name and other factors. Unfortunately, because the significance of the steno numbers was not understood at the time of microfilming, the cases were renumbered to put them in chronological order by the date of the trial. The steno numbers were retained and listed as "old numbers."

In 1975, as part of a reorganization of the records keeping of the City of New York, a large number of the transcripts in the Criminal Court Library were moved to storage. These were packed in boxes, and sent to the Municipal Records Center. The Records Center inventory shows a gap in the steno numbers which are in storage. Again, personnel changes were responsible for the fact that no one realized at that time that the first 3666 numbered transcripts had been sent to John Jay. There is now an established procedure by which transcripts are transferred to the Records Center for storage when the Criminal Court Library becomes too crowded.

At present, items with steno numbers from 3667 to 8000 are stored by the Municipal Records Office, while the more recent transcripts are housed in the Criminal Court Library. A card index, arranged by defendant's name, for all transcripts is available in the Criminal Court Library. Anyone wishing to use an item in storage must apply at the Criminal Court Library. The transcripts will usually be sent to the Criminal Court Library from the Records Office within a week's time. A copy of the microfilm and the John Jay index will also be made available to the Criminal Court Library, so that anyone doing research into transcripts there will have access to the complete set

Following are a number of lists which add information to the John Jay Index. They were created through a study of both the index file of the New York City Criminal Court, and the first record book from the Appeals Bureau which covers cases sent on appeal from the beginning of the sequence of stenographic numbers through the year 1929.

The first list fills in stenographic numbers for cases in the John Jay collection for which an "old number" had not been found on the transcript. The first list is arranged by John Jay number. The second list is a rearrangement of the first list by defendant name.

The third list consists of stenographic numbers for transcripts which appear to be missing from the collection at John Jay. The names were found through a search of the Appeals Bureau record book by matching names to numbers which were missing in the "old number" file of the John Jay index. In many cases the John Jay collection has transcripts of trials for these defendants which may form only part of the record, or are combined transcripts from which the numbers may have been missing. In cases where the record book indicates more than one number for a particular defendant, these are included. If the John Jay collection contains transcripts for the particular defendant although the number in question is missing, the related numbers are indicated. These are always steno numbers or "old numbers" as they are called in the John Jay index. No attempt has been made to list the corresponding John Jay numbers which can be found by looking in the John Jay Index. In many cases due to illegibility and spelling peculiarities in the transcription of oral testimony, errors were made which result in numbers being assigned twice, or to the wrong people. The notes indicate such errors when

possible The fourth list is a rearrangement of the missing case list by defendant name

After a diligent search, I have determined that some numbers are completely missing. There is no record of them in the record book and one can only conclude that they were lost prior to entry into the record book or that for some reason those numbers were erroneously omitted when numbers were being assigned to the transcripts.

Finally, there are some miscellaneous problems and errors which seemed important enough to mention. This does not exhaust the many problems which were found during my search through the record book and card file. Nor does it include the many names of defendants not listed in the John Jay Index, but who nevertheless appear as co-defendants in the record book. There were likewise, co-defendants listed in the John Jay Index who were not included in the record book. Anyone using the collection should at least be aware that these problems exist, and should therefore proceed with caution in any analysis of the cases, statistical or otherwise.
